School Handbook Revisions

Admission Policy (pg.7) Added to the policy:

The terms and conditions of the Tuition and Registration Contract are incorporated herein to the School Handbook including parish financial support, registration fee, tuition payment, additional costs, state immunization form, background checks, parent volunteer requirement, support of school fundraising, student photos, and the withdrawal policy.

Awards (pg. 15) Grade Seven Scholarship Award is amended to read as follows:

One Grade Seven academic scholarship will be awarded to a graduating 7th grade student. To qualify for the award, the student must have the highest GPA in the 7th grade class and must return to St. Brendan for his/her 8th grade year. The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000 awarded in the form of a tuition credit and applied to tuition for 8th grade. In the event more than one student shares the top GPA, the award will be split evenly. Additional funds may be available for this scholarship, and if so, the recipient (s) will receive this as well. The scholarship will be announced at the last School Mass in June.

Uniform Policy

PE Uniforms (pg. 51)

Grades 4-8- PE shorts may not be more than three inches above the knee.

Girls will wear a tee-shirt with a round collar and not a low cut v-neck or scoop neck.

Non-Uniform (pg. 52)

Free dress (non-uniform) is generally allowed once each month (on first Fridays) is amended to read:

Free dress (non-uniform) is generally allowed once each month (on first Fridays) unless there is a church liturgy scheduled for the first Friday. When there is a church liturgy (except for daily Mass), students will be required to wear a full school uniform.

A subsequent day in the month (such as the third Friday) will be designated as a non-uniform day to replace the first Friday.

Parents are advised to watch the school bulletin and web site for information on first Friday liturgies.

Other (non-uniform) (pg. 53)

The following items are added: Sweatpants and/or warm-up pants may not be worn at any time. Girls may wear leggings provided the outer garment is not more than three inches above the knee.
